## **Bikes for Kids**

Know of a child in need of a bike? Bring them in to pick one out for free, up to 20" wheel size! Parents or guardians need to be present to receive the bicycle. Helmets may be available.

Build-A-Bike - Saturdays at 10 a.m. by appointment

Youth ages 10-18 who need a larger bike can select a bike to fix up themselves. We will provide one-on-one assistance and any needed parts or supplies. An adult is not required to attend but is welcome to, and the session usually lasts between 1.5 and 2 hours.

## Earn a Bike

You can Earn-a-Bike by volunteering at Bike Walk Wichita's ReCycle Shop. Earn-a-Bike requires 15 hours of volunteer time. After you have completed those 15 hours, you can select one of the basic bikes we have to refurbish and will come with a lock and lights.

We also offer specialized courses that focus on specific components such as: Basic Mechanics • Axles, Hubs, and Bottom Brackets • Wheel building • Shifting and Derailleurs • and more. We also offer Bike Jam events where The ReCycle Shop will bring a skills course to your location and teach children basic street safety and riding skills.
